



JOHN G. PETERSON

John G. Peterson was born in 1790 in New Jersey. He married Mary Vail May 13, 1809, in Muskingum Co., Ohio, and moved to Richland Co. by 1817.

They had 10 children who married in Richland or Ashland Co. Most of them lived and died in that area and are buried in Peterson-Vail Cemetery.

ANDREW RICHEY

Andrew Richey, born 1765 in Ireland, emigrated to America with two brothers before 1786. He married 28 Mar 1788 Elizabeth (Ferguson) Aitken, a 1770 Irish native, and raised 12 children:

Robert McCurdy; 3) James; 4) Isabella m
Robert McDermut; 5) Andrew m Jane Marshall;

James Chew; 9) Robert; 10) Polly; 11) Henderson m Jane Patterson; and 12) John m/l Mary Throgmorton, m/2 Rachel Bell.

After a stint in Luzerne Twp. (1790) and German Twp. (1800), Fayette Co., Pa., they removed about 1803 to Wayne Twp., Jefferson Co., Ohio. In 1814-15, Richey purchased 640 acres in Milton, Monroe and Washington Twps., Richland Co., settling along the Rocky Fork.

In 1817 Andrew Richey was elected justice of the peace of Monroe Twp. He bought Mifflin Twp. land in 1822 and spent his remaining years there, operating his farm, apple nursery and raising horses, cattle and sheep.

In his 1833 will, Richey gave his son "a pew in the Brick Meetinghouse in the Town of Mansfield" -- no doubt the brick Presbyterian church erected before 1830 on the square. Andrew Richey died 14 Sep 1847.

Elizabeth -- known for her fiery red hair and beautiful hand-woven bedspreads -- followed him to their Wallace Road graves 20 Mar 1855.

Of their offspring, Samuel, Newville wheelright and chairmaker, was secretary of Richland Co.'s temperance society and Henderson was Mansfield's sheriff.

JOHN MOYER

John Moyer, son of Christian and Anna Meyer, was born 22 Sep 1795 in Manheim Twp, Lancaster Co., Pa. He married Elizabeth Ahner/Ahrer, born 20 Jan 1799. In 1826 they moved to Ashland Co.

Sons were Christian, born 26 Feb 1828, and George A., born 13 Mar 1833.

Elizabeth died 4 Apr 1838. John married a woman 16 years his junior, Catherine of Boyer, Germany, and eventually had 11 children.

In the fall of 1849, John moved to Elkhart Co., Ind. George married Mary, daughter of Joseph Rohrer, (14 Dec 1837-7 Jan 1910) before joining his father there in 1854.

MICHAEL SHANABARGER

Michael Shanabarger was born 21 Nov 1769, probably in Pennsylvania or Maryland. His parents may have been Michael and Magdalena Shanabarger who lived in Frederick Co., Md.

Michael married Mary Long, daughter of Christopher and Anna Ursula Long of Middletown, Frederick Co., Md. They moved to Monroe Twp., Richland Co., with their children between 1816-1818.

They had 12 children, all born in Maryland: 1) Elizabeth m the Rev. Michael David Schue; 2) Jacob m Margaret Long; 3) Christina m Jacob Koogle; 4) Catherine m Jacob Keefer; 5) John L. m Elizabeth Royer;

6) Henry m Sarah "Sally" Royer; 7) George m Sarah ?; 8) Mary m Samuel Royer; 9) Nancy died enroute to Ohio; 10) Barbara m Jonathan Sackman; 11) Peter m Catarine Ohl; and 12) Samuel m Eliza Ann Castle

The Shanabargers were Lutheran and Michael donated land for Mt. Zion Church and Cemetery and later land for a school, standing on Ohio 39 near Lucas. His log house was used for early church services and he also housed ministers in his home.

Michael died in 1844, and Mary in 1865, age 90. Both are buried in Mt. Zion Cemetery.
